### TUITION AND FEE INFORMATION Academic Year 2018-2019

SAN DIEGO FRENCH-AMERICAN SCHOOL offers three payment plans designed to meet the budgetary needs of our families. Plan A, offers a discount for one-time full tuition paid via check or wire transfer.

The FACTS plan, utilizes the services of FACTS Tuition Management Company to offer either a two payments (Plan B), or a monthly payment plan option (Plan C).

There are **two non-refundable fees due with the enrollment agreement in order to reserve a student's space in our school**: a **\$1,000 tuition deposit**, which is credited towards tuition, and an **annual fee** (dollar amount depends on grade).

A non-refundable, **one-time admission fee of \$1,000 for new students only**, is due with the enrollment agreement in addition to the Tuition Deposit. **The admission fee for siblings of new or current student is \$500.**

Annual fees are for the entire school year, all rates are listed in U.S. dollars.

Tuition (but not annual fee), is prorated on a bi-monthly basis if a student joins San Diego French-American School after the beginning of the academic year. In which case, any payments normally due by the first day of school must accompany the enrollment agreement.

### TUITION PAYMENT OPTIONS:

**Plan A, a one-time payment plan, can be paid by check or wire transfer.** Please note that the only installment method of payment accepted by the Financial Office for tuition and fee payment is FACTS for **Plan B, a two installments payments plan** and FACTS for **Plan C, a 10 monthly payments plan.** FACTS is a service that provides automatic deduction from a checking or savings account for fixed monthly fees. Should there be a failure to maintain timely payments per the financial arrangements agreed upon with San Diego French-American School, finance charges may be assessed on any past due balance. A \$16 charge will be assessed for each returned check. On the first day of school, a student may not be admitted to class unless at least 20% of the annual tuition, the annual and administrative fee (if applicable) have been paid. Students may not be enrolled for the following school year while there are delinquent amounts outstanding.

### ANNUAL FEE:

San Diego French-American School makes every effort to limit additional fees to voluntary or extra-curricular activities, as well as certain consumables. The annual fee covers the cost of textbooks, classroom and testing materials, insurance, school t-shirt, agenda, workbooks, notebooks, local field trips and transportation, preschool snacks, and Parent's Association fee.

### FINANCIAL AID:

Limited funds are available each year to provide financial assistance to families that have demonstrated a financial need. Additional information is available on our website: [www.sdfrenchschool.org](http://www.sdfrenchschool.org) under the Admissions tab. All information submitted is handled confidentially. Families should inquire about this option as soon as they apply to the school due to the limited time frame to submit requests. To be considered for financial aid, returning families are required to be in good financial standing with SDFAS.

### FRENCH NATIONAL SCHOLARSHIPS:

French nationals three years and older may be eligible for scholarships offered by the French Government. Requests must be submitted by the deadline determined by the French Consulate.
