Dear parents,

You'll find on this document the several points that were addressed during the BTS night on Tuesday, September 8.

Humanities

- A book pick-up for DL students will be organized in the coming week.
- Hard copies of English / Social Studies books will be available for pick-up too.
- Reading digital books for Literature class and for book reports is acceptable (English, Spanish and French). Email the title to the teacher beforehand so it can be approved for book reports.

STEAM

- Science and Math curricula are accessible online on the website, more detailed curricula will be shared on google classrooms.
- Students will be able to use the lab occasionally to work on lab experiments that don't require working in groups.
- Online tools are used to recreate experiments that cannot be done in the lab
- Algebra 1 Math classes will be offered soon online to 8th grade students
- Fraction Clinics will be offered soon online to 6th grade students
- Art and PE will be offered soon through asynchronous work and check-ins with DL students.

General Organization

- Students are still expected to use paper planners and notebooks in addition to Google Classroom & Calendar
- To access Google Classroom, please use your child's email address and password
- Students don't have to bring their textbooks to school as they are accessible online, except for 6th grade Grammar books
- Students should bring the novels they are studying in literature class
- All the schedules with the links are accessible in the class' advisory classroom.
- During drop-off students should wait **inside the lower field parking lot** near the field's gate : waiting on the sidewalk isn't advised for safety reasons.
